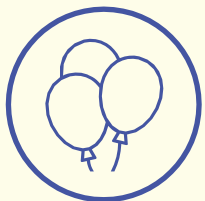

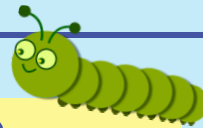

This month, Juniors have enjoyed fine motor craft experiences such as beading, clay and playdough.

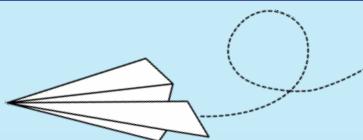
We are always so excited to take home our creations and to share our achievements with our peers.

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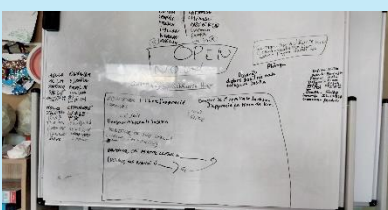
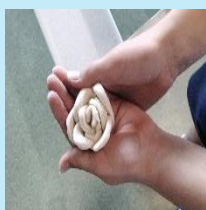


Middle Room
